### Job Overview

The Field Supervisor, under the direction of the Operations Manager, is primarily responsible for managing, coordinating, and directing on-site operations and training in an oilfield setting. The Field Supervisor will provide input into on-site decisions regarding solving problems, meeting regulatory requirements, and achieving objectives. This individual must have excellent problem-solving skills, including responding to mechanical failures and solving interpersonal issues between employees. The Field Supervisor will serve as a liaison between frontline workers and management.

### Key Accountabilities

- Manage, coordinate, and direct on-site operations and training.
- Provide input into on-site decisions regarding solving problems, meeting regulatory requirements, and achieving objectives.
- Identify hazards and recommend appropriate action to eliminate or control employee exposure to hazards.
- Coordinate, direct, supervise, and monitor the execution of projects to ensure that specifications are met.
- Monitor, measure, and report on the progress of projects, and implement corrective measures to optimize the use of available resources.
- Complete and file all safety and quality control paperwork in a timely and appropriate manner.
- Complete daily reports, as required.
- Ensure compliance with quality control and safety manuals.
- Respond to mechanical failures and formulate plans to repair or replace broken equipment.
- Solve billing issues relating to materials and services.
- Respond to employee concerns in an appropriate manner and take action to resolve the underlying issues.
- Complete all work and meet pre-determined objectives within budgetary, resource, and time constraints.
- Order site-specific materials and supplies.
- Supervise operators and labourers.
- Support the implementation of safety plans, procedures, and initiatives.
- Ensure that all workers on-site comply with applicable safety regulations and standards.

- Participate in training and development activities.
- Other duties as required.

- Ability to work under pressure and meet tight deadlines.
- Knowledge and understanding of fluid movement, pumps and pumping would be an asset.
